1. Frankel won the QIPCO 2000 Guineas at the Rowley Mile in 2011. Can you name the runner-up who finished six lengths behind the historic winner? *Dubawi Gold*
2. How long is the straight at the Rowley Mile? *12f*
3. A bronze statue of which for Champion jockey was unveiled in the Rowley Mile parade ring in October 2019? *Lester Piggott*
4. Pinatubo received a rating of 128 following his outstanding juvenile campaign, making him the highest-rated juvenile in 25 years. Which horse was the last to be given a mark higher than 128 as a juvenile? *Celtic Swing (130 in 1994)*
5. Which jockey has won more renewals of the QIPCO 2000 Guineas, Frankie Dettori or Ryan Moore? *Dettori 3, Moore 2*
6. What is the name given to the July Course's straight mile track? *The Bunbury Mile*
7. Tropics finished second in back-to-back renewals of the Darley July Cup in 2014 and 2015. Which two sprinters defeated him in those two races? *Slade Power (2014), Muhaarar (2015)*
8. Sir Michael Stoute trained Veracious to win the Tattersalls Falmouth Stakes in 2019. How many times has the Newmarket-based trainer won the Group 1 contest for fillies and mares? *Six*
9. Frankel famously made his debut at the July Course, getting the better of a battle with Nathaniel in a high-class Maiden Stakes. Frankel and Nathaniel won Group 1 races in their career but there was another subsequent Group 1 winner down the field on that Friday night at the July Course. Can you name the horse? *Colour Vision (2012 Gold Cup, Royal Ascot)*
10. The Newmarket Racecourses site straddles the border of Suffolk and Cambridgeshire. In which county does the July Course sit? *Cambridgeshire*
