

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The promoter is Haydock Park Racecourse, Newton-le-Willows, Merseyside, WA12 0HQ
- 2. Staff and immediate family members of the Promoter, sponsors and partners are not eligible to enter
- 3. By entering the competition, entrants accept the Promoter's terms and conditions when submitting an entry. All entries will be entered into a database and the Promoter and/or partners may use Contestants' names and contact details for future marketing purposes if the Contestant has specifically ticked to be contacted. Contestants can be omitted from this thereafter, under GDPR guidelines, by contacting Haydock Park Racecourse directly
- 4. Contestants agree that their image may be used on the ADI screens and TVs across the Course by the Promoter and also agree that the Promoter and partners can use their image for future marketing and promotional purposes, including a gallery section on the Promoter's Facebook page in relation to the specific competition and Rose of Lancaster Stakes Ladies' Day.
