

ORDER

UPON READING the application of the Claimant dated 1 February 2019

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The original classes of defendants to this Claim be replaced with the above named classes of defendant;
2. The above claim be listed for trial with a listing of 1 day.
3. Any additional evidence on which the Claimant seeks to rely should be filed not less than 14 days before the trial date;
4. The Claimant should file a skeleton argument not less than 7 days before the trial date;
5. If any person applies to be added to this Claim as a named Defendant in accordance with the terms of the Order of Nugee J dated 24 October 2018 then this Court shall re-appraise the directions for trial.

Service of the Application

6. Pursuant to CPR r.6.27 the following steps shall be good and sufficient service of the application for this Order:
 - a. the Claimant shall affix sealed copies of the 'Take Note Notice' attached to this Order notifying potential defendants of this application in transparent envelopes to posts, gates, fences and hedges at conspicuous locations on the Racecourse Land including at entrances to the Racecourse Land and as more particularly shown in yellow on the attached Plan.
 - b. The notices shall be affixed by 8 February 2019 and remain in place for a minimum of two weeks.
 - c. The Claimant shall post an electronic copy of the 'Take Note Notice' on the Cheltenham Racecourse website www.cheltenham.co.uk by 8 February 2019 and this shall remain in place for a minimum of two weeks.
 - d. The Claimant shall leave a sealed copy of this application and accompanying documents and cause a copy to be available for inspection during normal office opening hours of the administrative offices of Cheltenham Racecourse GL50 4SH (Mon-Fri 0830-1730 excluding Bank Holidays and closed days

advertised on the Cheltenham Racecourse website). Such a copy is to be available for a minimum of two weeks.

Service of this Order

7. Pursuant to CPR r6.27 the following steps shall be good and sufficient service of this Order:
 - a. The Claimant shall affix sealed copies of this Order in transparent envelopes to posts, gates, fences and hedges at conspicuous locations on the Racecourse Land including at entrances to the Racecourse Land and as more particularly shown in yellow on the attached Plan.
 - b. The sealed copies of the Order shall remain in place for a minimum of four weeks.
 - c. The Claimant shall post an electronic copy of this Order on the Cheltenham Racecourse website www.cheltenham.co.uk such copy shall remain in place for a minimum of four weeks.
 - d. The Claimant shall leave a sealed copy of this Order and cause a copy to be available for inspection during normal office opening hours of the administrative offices of Cheltenham Racecourse GL50 4SH (Mon-Fri 0830-1730 excluding Bank Holidays and closed days advertised on the Cheltenham Racecourse website). Such a copy shall be available for a minimum of four weeks.
