

CHELTENHAM RACECOURSE JUNIOR JUMPERS™ COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By entering the Junior Jumpers Competition on Wednesday 3rd July 2019 the terms and conditions (as defined below), entrants agree to be bound by these Rules and your attention is specifically drawn to the conditions No. 10, No.12 and No. 16.
2. In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the Competition, the decision of Cheltenham Racecourse shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
3. Cheltenham Racecourse assumes that by reading the publication or by using the website and entering the Competition (and you warrant that) you are a Junior Jumper member and under the age of 18 (or will be entering the competition on behalf of someone who is).
4. Employees of Cheltenham Racecourse or any associated company of the Racecourse and their immediate families, persons connected with the competition i.e. prize sponsors, newsagents, wholesalers & their agents are not able to enter the Competition
