Dear Resident

We are looking forward to The Festival at Cheltenham Racecourse which starts on Tuesday 10th March – Friday 13th March 2020. There will be a change in traffic management which I would like to make you aware of.

On each day of The Festival as racegoers leave the racecourse, a section of New Barn Lane between the main racecourse roundabout and the junction with Albert Road will be SHUT to non-racing traffic. Signs will be put up two weeks prior as a reminder to residents this will be happening.

This is to improve the safety of the many thousands of pedestrians who leave the racecourse on foot as well as improving the movement of local bus services to the centre of town and the station. The road will be closed between the approximate hours of 1630 and 1930 – this could be open earlier if safety permits. The A435 will also have road closures as in previous years.

We have worked alongside both Gloucestershire Police and the local council to make sure the safety of our racegoers as well as for the local residents is of utmost importance.

Those who will need access to residences or businesses in close proximity to the racecourse will still be able to reach their destination. Please just inform the stewards of where you need to reach and they will be able to accommodate you.

I hope that this road closure does not cause too much inconvenience to your journey on these four days and thank you for your continued support of Cheltenham Racecourse.
