FACTS

1. The original 1924 Cheltenham Gold Cup weighs an impressive 644grams!
2. Just eight horses have won the Cheltenham Gold Cup more than once, they are Easter hero, Golden Miller, Cottage Rake, Arkle, L'Escargot, Best Mate, Kauto Star and Al Boum Photo
3. The only horse to win the Cheltenham Gold Cup & Grand National at Aintree in the same season is Golden Miller back in 1934
4. In the Grand National, horses have to complete two laps of the course, covering four-and-a-half miles and jumping 30 fences. There are 16 different jumps, known as fences, on the National Course.
5. The father of ALL racehorses: Scientists discover majority of modern thoroughbreds are descended from the British stallion Eclipse. Modern racehorses are virtually all descended from a legendary British stallion called Eclipse.

LET'S GET BAKING!



Any day is made better with some cake! Why not try our delicious lemon drizzle cake? An exclusive recipe from one of our Jockey Club Racecourse Chefs! Good luck, and enjoy!

Don't forget to ask a responsible adult to help.

INGREDIENTS

- 275g Self Raising Flour
- 225g Caster Sugar
- 225g Butter Soft
- 4 Eggs
- 2 Lemons Zest
- 4 tbsp Milk
- 2 tbsp Baking Powder
- 175g Granulated Sugar

DIRECTIONS

1. Pre-Heat the oven to 170°C/150°C (Fan) /Gas 3
2. Grease a baking tin and then line with grease proof paper
3. Mix all the ingredients (except the granulated sugar and lemon juice) into a large bowl and beat well for about two minutes until well blended
4. Bake in the middle of a pre-heated oven for about 35-40 minutes or until the cake springs back when pressed lightly
5. Allow the cake to cool for a few minutes in the tin
6. Mix the lemon juice and granulated sugar in a small bowl to give a runny consistency
7. Spoon this mixture evenly over the cake whilst it is still warm
8. Cut into squares when cool
