

EXETER RACECOURSE LADIES DAY COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By entering the Best Dressed Ladies Day competition at Exeter Racecourse, the terms and conditions (as defined below), entrants agree to be bound by these Rules, that the competition will be run by a random generator and your attention is specifically drawn to the conditions No. 10, No.13 and No. 18.
2. In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition, the decision of Exeter Racecourse shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
3. To qualify to enter the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition, you must be a resident in the United Kingdom, Republic of Ireland and/or the Isle of Man. The address you provide with your competition entry ("Entry") may be used to send any prizes so please make sure this is correct.
4. Exeter Racecourse assumes that by reading the publication or by using the website and entering the Ladies Day Competition (and you warrant that) you are aged 18 or over.
5. Employees of Exeter Racecourse or any associated company of Exeter Racecourse and their immediate families, persons connected with the competition i.e. prize sponsors, newsagents, wholesalers & their agents are not able to enter the Best Dressed Competition.
6. By entering the Competition, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete. Exeter Racecourse reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.
7. Exeter Racecourse reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the Rules.
8. Only one entry per person per Competition is allowed, any entrant who enters more than the permitted maximum will be disqualified.
9. Where the Ladies Day Best Dressed winner has been selected and Exeter Racecourse discovers or has reasonable grounds to believe the winner has made more than one Entry, Exeter Racecourse reserves the right to select an alternative winner.
10. Entries to Exeter Racecourses' Ladies Day Best Dressed competition must be made by the end of the third race by the roaming activation team. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
11. A ticket is required to enter the Racecourse. There is no purchase requirement to enter the Ladies Day Best Dressed Competition.
12. Entrants should note that unless stated otherwise, Exeter Racecourse does not accept responsibility for the return of any Entries, including those consisting of artistic or other material.
13. Prize winners will be notified on the day of the competition, Sunday 10th February.
14. The winners will be selected at random through an online independent random number generator for people who have entered via the Priority SMS promotion at the raceday.
15. There are five prizes in total to be won by five different entrants.
16. Claims for prizes must be made on the day. Failure to claim a prize by 5:00pm on Sunday 10th February will result in disqualification and your prize may be donated to Racing Welfare.
17. Exeter Racecourse Best Dressed Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. Exeter Racecourse reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at any time.
18. Exeter Racecourse Best Dressed prizes are awarded at the discretion of Exeter Racecourse and no prizes will be awarded as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any entrant.
19. Prize winners shall not, under any circumstances whatsoever, sell or transfer their prize to any other person(s) within six months of Sunday 10th February. Selling or transferring prizes includes, but is not limited to, selling and/or distributing on any website including any auction

site whether it is operated by a third party or by a prize winner. Should the prize winner sell or attempt to sell any prize within six months, the prize winner agrees to repay the full market value of the prize to Exeter Racecourse who will in turn transfers funds to Racing Welfare.

20. Your Exeter Racecourse Best Dressed entry and any information submitted by you must be personal to and relate specifically to you. You hereby warrant that your entry and all information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Exeter Racecourse reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

Exeter Racecourse cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the Best Dressed competition or as a result of accepting any prize. Exeter Racecourse is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment or software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, telephone lines or at any web site, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile telephone related to or resulting from participation in the Competition. Nothing shall exclude Exeter Racecourse's liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

22. Winners may be requested to take part in promotional activity and Exeter Racecourse reserves the right to use the names and addresses of winners in any publicity both in paper and online.

Where the site and/or the Interactive Services are accessed from Scotland or Northern Ireland, this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Scotland or Northern Ireland respectively and you hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts or the courts of Northern Ireland respective
