

WINCANTON RACECOURSE LADIES NIGHT COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By entering the Best Dressed competition (the competition) at Wincanton Racecourse, the terms and conditions (as defined below), entrants agree to be bound by these Rules and your attention is specifically drawn to the conditions No. 10, No.13, No.14 and No. 18.
2. In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the Competition, the decision of Wincanton Racecourse shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
3. To qualify to enter the Competition, you must be a resident in the United Kingdom, Republic of Ireland and/or the Isle of Man. The address you provide with your competition entry ("Entry") may be used to send any prizes so please make sure this is correct.
4. Wincanton Racecourse assumes that by reading the publication or by using the website and entering the Competition (and you warrant that) you are aged 18 or over.
5. Employees of Wincanton Racecourse or any associated company of Wincanton Racecourse and their immediate families, persons connected with the competition i.e. prize sponsors, newsagents, wholesalers & their agents are not able to enter the Competition.
6. By entering the Competition, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete. Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.
7. Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the Rules.
8. Only one entry per person per Competition is allowed.
9. Where the 1st place and two runner up places have been selected and Wincanton Racecourse discovers or has reasonable grounds to believe the winner has made more than one Entry, Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right to select an alternative winner.
10. Entries to the competition must be made at 6pm at the sculpture by the parade ring. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
11. A ticket is required to enter the Racecourse. There is no purchase requirement to enter the Competition.
12. Racegoers wishing to enter the competition will be asked to come to the sculpture by the parade ring at 6pm where the top six will be selected by the racecourse judging panel. The top six will then be asked to return to the parade ring at 6:30pm where the final three in order of 1st and two runners up will be selected by our independent judging panel and awarded their relevant prizes.
13. Prize winners will be notified on the day of the competition, Thursday 9th May shortly after 6:30pm when the top three are invited to the parade ring. There is a top prize for 1st place and two runner up prize bundles to be won by three separate individuals. Claims for prizes must be made on the day in the parade ring at the prize giving.
14. Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at any time.
15. Competition prizes are awarded at the discretion of Wincanton Racecourse and no prizes will be awarded as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any entrant.
16. Your entry to the competition and any information submitted by you must be personal to and relate specifically to you. You hereby warrant that your entry and all information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

17. Wincanton Racecourse cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the competition or as a result of accepting any prize. Wincanton Racecourse is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment or software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, telephone lines or at any web site, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile telephone related to or resulting from participation in the Competition. Nothing shall exclude Wincanton Racecourse's liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

18. Winners may be requested to take part in promotional activity and Wincanton Racecourse reserves the right to use the names and addresses of winners in any publicity both in paper and online.

20. Data relating to entrants of the Competition will be retained by Wincanton Racecourse for a reasonable period after the Competition closes to assist Wincanton Racecourse to operate competitions in a consistent manner.

21. The Competition and Rules will be governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England. Where the site and/or the Interactive Services are accessed from Scotland or Northern Ireland, this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Scotland or Northern Ireland respectively and you hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts or the courts of Northern Ireland respectively
