

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The promoter is Aintree Racecourse, Ormskirk Road, Liverpool, L9 5AS
- 2. Staff and immediate family members of the Promoter, Sponsors and Partners are not eligible to enter
- 3. All entrants must reside in the United Kingdom, with a UK address and possess a full, valid UK driving licence
- 4. By entering the competition Contestants accept the Promoter's terms and conditions and must tick their acceptance when submitting their entry. All entries will be entered into a database and the Promoter and/or Partners may use Contestants' names and contact details for future marketing purposes, unless notified to the contrary by the Contestant by de-selecting the tick in the relevant box
- 5. Contestants' agree that their image may be used on the ADI and TV screens at the venue and during the Festival by the Promoter. They also agree that the Promoter and Partners can use their image for future marketing and promotional purposes, including a gallery section on the Promoter's website
- 6. The winner/s will be required to take part in all relevant publicity during and up to a full year after Ladies Day, Friday 3rd April 2020
- 7. The judges will be looking for the most stylish person/s on the course, based on the following criteria:

- 8. The Promoter shall select the judging panel and the judges' decision will be final

- 16. Final judging will take place once entries have closed and the finalists will be notified by 3.30pm via the ADI and TV screens at the racecourse
- 17. Once notified all finalists must make their own way to the Red Rum Garden where they should make themselves known to the Promoter, located at the front of the stage, by no later than 3.40pm on Friday 3rd April 2020. Failure to arrive by this time will result in disqualification from the competition
- 18. The winner will be announced at 4.15pm on the Style Stage in the Red Rum Garden on Friday 3rd April 2020
- 19. The Promoter reserves the right to amend the above timings on the day and will use the ADI and TV screens, as well as the PA system, to announce any changes to contestants
- 20. Entry is solely via the official competition mechanism stated and all photographic entries must be via the Promoter's appointed photographers. Contestants are required to have their photograph taken in the designated style frames and locations. They must then log their details with the assigned promotional staff located at each of the entry points. Failure to do so will result in the entry not being logged. For the avoidance of any doubt, contestants who do not submit details, or the incorrect contact details, will not be entered into the competition or will be disqualified
