RANDEX HEALTH GRAND NATIONAL ANNIVERSARIES IN 2020

2010
10 YEARS AGO

A P McCoy, the most successful Jump jockey of all time, finally wins the world's greatest chase on his 15th attempt aboard Don't Push It. It is also a first Grand National success for leading owner J P McManus and trainer Jonjo O'Neill.

2000
20 YEARS AGO

Jockey Ruby Wash wins his first Grand National aboard Papillon, trained by his father Ted. A major gamble on the day of the race sees Papillon come down from 33/1 in the morning to a starting price at 10/1.

1990
30 YEARS AGO

Mr Frisk records the fastest time ever in the Grand National, coming home in 8m 47.80s under Marcus Armytage. Now racing correspondent of the Daily Telegraph, Armytage is the latest amateur rider to win the great race.

1980
40 YEARS AGO

American amateur Charlie Fenwick partners 40/1 chance Ben Nevis to victory. It is the second of three Grand National victories for trainer Tim Forster. Forster, always a notorious pessimist, simply told Fenwick "to keep on remounting". The formidable Mirabel Topham, the public face of Aintree Racecourse for many years, passes away aged 88.

1970
50 YEARS AGO

Gay Trip hands trainer Fred Rimell the third of his joint-record four Grand National successes. Rimell's stable jockey Terry Biddlecombe misses the ride through injury and Gay Trip is partnered by 40-year-old Pat Taaffe, who rides his second Grand National winner after Quare Times in 1955.

1960
60 YEARS AGO

The Grand National is broadcast live on television for the first time by the BBC. The 36.5 per cent of households with a TV set at the time witness 13/2 chance Merryman II come home in front under Gerry Scott for trainer Neville Crump, who is saddling his second Grand National winner following Sheila's Cottage in 1948. Winning jockey Gerry Scott partnered Merryman II with a heavily strapped up collarbone, having broken it in two places just 12 days earlier.

1950
70 YEARS AGO

Freebooter was, until the advent of Red Rum, regarded as the best of the post-war winners, scoring by a very easy 15 lengths under 11st 11lb. Freebooter has an outstanding record over the Grand National course, winning five times from eight starts. He also landed the Champion Chase, Becher Chase and the Grand Sefton Chase (twice). He was owned by Lurline Brotherton, who would own Red Rum for part of his career.

RANDEX HEALTH GRAND NATIONAL ANNIVERSARIES IN 2020

1940
80 YEARS AGO

Aintree had been occupied by the military since the outbreak of World War II. The government granted special dispensation for the 1940 Grand National to be run, with the course defended by a squadron of Spitfires flying overhead. The race is won by Bogskar under jockey Mervyn Jones. Jones was granted special leave to ride at Aintree but tragically in 1942 disappeared when flying a Spitfire on a reconnaissance mission over Norway. He was just 22 years old. The Grand National would not return to Aintree until 1946.

1930
90 YEARS AGO

Shaun Gollin wins in one of the race's closest finishes, beating Melleray's Belle by a neck. Shaun Gollin, who once changed hands for a mere 20 guineas, was the result of an unplanned mating. His dam reputedly escaped from her paddock and was covered by an unbroken three-year-old colt, thought to be called Shaun Aboo.

1920
100 YEARS AGO

Terrible conditions mean little can be seen from the stands as the giant Troytown makes all the running to hand jockey Jack Anthony his third Grand National win.

1910
110 YEARS AGO

Jenkinstown gave trainer Tom Coulthwaite the second of his three Grand National wins. The runner-up was Jerry M, who was conceding 30lb to Jenkinstown and would go on to win the 1912 Grand National.

1900
120 YEARS AGO

Ambush II becomes the first, and so far only, Royal Grand National winner as he carries the colours of the Prince of Wales to victory. Less than a year later, the Prince finally accedes to the throne as King Edward VII. Manifesto, the outstanding winner in 1897 and 1899, is a gallant third under the welter burden of 12st 13lb.

1870
150 YEARS AGO

The Colonel wins for the second year and hands jockey George Stevens the last of his record five Grand National wins. The Colonel attempted the hat-trick in 1871, but could only finish fourth to The Lamb.

1850
170 YEARS AGO

The first win for Abd-El-Kader. The tiny horse would go on to win again in 1851 and become the first dual Grand National winner. Affectionately known as "Little Ab" he attempted the hat-trick in 1852, finishing fifth.

POTENTIAL LANDMARKS IN THE 2020 RANDOX HEALTH GRAND NATIONAL

Tiger Roll is aiming to become the second triple winner alongside Red Rum and the first horse to win three consecutive Grand Nationals.

Trainer **Gordon Elliott** is seeking his fourth Grand National win. Elliott, who also triumphed with Silver Birch in 2007, would join Fred Rimell and Ginger McCain as the most successful trainer in Grand National history.

Former Manchester United manager **Sir Alex Ferguson**, along with Ged Mason and Peter Done have entered Give Me A Copper, winner of Wincanton's Badger Beers Silver Trophy Handicap Chase in November.

Owners **Trevor Hemmings** (Hedgehunter (2005), Ballabriggs (2011) and Many Clouds (2015)) and **Gigginstown House Stud** (Rule The World (2016) and Tiger Roll (2018 & 2019)) are both attempting to become the first owner to win the Grand National four times. The three other owners to have won the race three times are James Machell, Sir Charles Assheton-Smith (previously Charles Duff) and Noel Le Mare.

Rachael Blackmore, Bryony Frost or **Lizzie Kelly** would become the first female jockey to win the Grand National, if successful in 2020.

Leighton Aspell and **Davy Russell** are bidding for a third victory and would become only the seventh rider in the race's history to achieve this feat. Russell would become the first jockey to win three successive Grand Nationals. George Stevens holds the overall record with five successes.

The 2017 Grand National winner **One For Arthur**, now an 11-year-old, is set to return to Aintree after coming sixth in 2019. Only four horses have regained the Grand National – Red Rum (1973, 1974, 1977), Manifesto (1897 & 1899), The Lamb (1868 & 1871) and Peter Simple (1849 & 1853).

The first back-to-back winner of the Becher Chase, **Walk in the Mill**, who fared best of the British-trained Grand National contenders when fourth in the 2019, has again been entered and is owned by Jockey Club Steward, Baroness Dido Harding.

Champion jockey **Richard Johnson** holds the record for the most rides (21) in the Grand National. The previous record holder Sir AP McCoy rode in 20 Grand Nationals.

Nigel Twiston-Davies, successful with Earth Summit (1998) and Bindaree (2002), is bidding to become eighth trainer to win the race three times.

Trainers with entries seeking a second win are **Willie Mullins, Paul Nicholls, Jonjo O'Neill, David Pipe, Lucinda Russell, Sue Smith, Ted Walsh** and **Venetia Williams**.

Activial, Bristol De Mai, Flying Angel, Scoir Mear, Tout Est Permis and **Vintage Clouds** are all aiming to become the fourth grey horse to win the Grand National following The Lamb (1868 and 1871), Nicolaus Silver (1961) and Neptune Collonges (2012).

Atlanta Ablaze, Cabaret Queen, Shattered Love and last year's runner-up **Magic Of Light** could become the 14th mare to win the race.

AGE OF THE WINNERS

MOST COMMON WINNING AGE

Nine-year-old horses have won 46 of the 172 runnings of the Grand National where the winner's age was recorded.

OLDEST WINNER

Peter Simple (1853) is believed to be the oldest winner of the oldest Grand National at around 15 years of age, although the records are unclear and that he may have been anything between 12 and 17. The two fully substantiated oldest winners are Why Not (1894) and Sergeant Murphy (1923).

YOUNGEST WINNER

Alcibiade (1865), Regal (1876), Austerlitz (1877), Empress (1880) and Lutteur III (1909) were all aged five when successful in the Grand National.

Since 2012, only seven-year-olds and upwards can take part.

The last seven-year-old to succeed was Bogskar in 1940.

BETTING

SOME FAMOUS GAMBLERS

Lottery (1839) was made 5/1 favourite following his earlier success in the Cheltenham Steeplechase.

Another successful 19th century punt came to fruition in 1866 when owner/trainer Edward Studd had £1,000 at 40/1 about Salamander. His £40,000 winnings would equate to around £3 million at today's values.

Manifesto hit the bookies hard on both occasions he won the Grand National; in 1897 and 1899. He was sent off 6/1 favourite for his first win when owned by heavy-gambling Irish solicitor Harry Dyas. He was 5/1 second favourite two years later when scoring for new owner John Bulteel - the 4/1 favourite was his half-sister Gentle Ida, who fell. Manifesto ran in the Grand National a record eight times.

Golden Miller was the 2/1 market leader in 1935, making him the shortest-priced runner in the long history of the Grand National. Dorothy Paget's great chaser, who had captured the Aintree race in 1934 (at 8/1), unseated his jockey Gerry Wilson at the 11th fence as 22/1 chance Reynoldstown prevailed. Golden Miller, trained by Basil Briscoe, won the Cheltenham Gold Cup a record five times.

A confident Vincent O'Brien told owner Joe 'Mincemeat' Griffin to have a good bet on Early Mist, who started 20/1 for the 1953 renewal. Griffin won £100,000 when his horse triumphed and he also owned the 1954 winner Royal Tan, trained by Irish-based O'Brien too.

BETTING

SOME FAMOUS GAMBLERS CONTINUED

Prolific gambler Terry Ramsden bet £50,000 each-way at 8/1 about Mr Snugfit from Mick Easterby's Yorkshire stables in 1986. The horse, who was also combined in doubles and trebles, returned a profit when coming home fourth.

Papillon's success in 2000 for trainer Ted Walsh and his jockey son Ruby was a popular victory. Tipped by the Racing Post's Pricewise column at 33/1 on the morning, he was sent off at 10/1 by race time.

Part-owner Mike Futter estimated his total winnings were £800,000 when Monty's Pass scored in 2003. The five-person Dee Racing syndicate netted over £1 million on the winner, who started at 16/1, but had been backed down from 66/1 by his owners and others.

FAVOURITES

Since the turn of the century, four of the 20 Grand National winners have been clear or joint favourites.

The most recent favourite to succeed is Tiger Roll in 2019. His starting price of 4/1 makes him the shortest-priced winner since Poethlyn in 1919.

Golden Miller is the shortest-priced Grand National favourite ever, going off at 2/1 in 1935. The 1934 winner unseated his rider at the 11th fence.

Other short-priced favourites include Red Rum, who was the 7/2 market leader when beaten 15 lengths into second by L'Escargot in 1975, the 1965 and 1966 runner-up Freddie who was sent off at 7/2 and 11/4 respectively, and Prince Regent, winner of 14 races including the Cheltenham Gold Cup, who started the 3/1 market leader in 1946 and finished third under 12st 5lb.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money for the Randox Health Grand National has reached a colossal £1 million.

The level of prize money for the Aintree race has rocketed - £250,000 was on offer when Lord Gyllene won in 1997 before reaching £975,000 in 2012 and 2013, with the first £1-million Grand National in 2014.

The Randox Health Grand National is the richest Jump race in the world. Britain's second biggest prize money pot for a race over obstacles is offered by the Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup, worth £625,000.

RESERVES

Since 2000, every year bar four (2004-39, 2015-39, 2016-39, 2018-38) has seen a full field of 40 line up in the Grand National. This is partly due to a system of reserves begun in 2000.

The 40 declared runners for the Grand National are revealed over 48 hours before the race, shortly after 10am on the Thursday, and up to four reserves are decided then too.

The reserves can be utilised if one of the original declarations is a non-runner by 1pm (used to be 9am up to and including 2015) on the day before the race. The change to the deadline for reserves was made after Carlito Brigante was taken out in 2015 at 11.12am on the Friday, leaving 39 to face the starter.

A total of 10 reserves have run in the Randox Health Grand National.

SMALLEST NUMBER OF FINISHERS

Two horses finished in 1928, with Tipperary Tim beating the remounted Billy Barton by a distance. Easter Hero hit the Canal Turn on the first circuit and fell back into the ditch which then preceded the fence and impeded runners behind him.

There were three finishers in 1882, 1913 and 1951 (in both 1913 and 1951 the third horse was remounted).

More recently, only four finished in 2001. A loose horse (Paddy's Return) at the Canal Turn the first time around put paid to the chances of a quarter of the 40 starters and then the heavy going did not suit many others. Red Marauder and Smarty were the only two horses to negotiate the 30 fences at the first attempt. Blowing Wind and Papillon, who both came to grief at the 19th, were remounted to finish third and fourth respectively.

The remounting of horses was banned in all races by the British Horseracing Authority in November, 2009.

MOST FINISHERS

23 went past the winning post in 1984, from 40 starters.

There were 22 finishers in 1963, 1987 and 1992.

MOST RUNNERS

66 in 1929.

The maximum field size is now 40.

LEAST RUNNERS

10 lined up in 1883.

TIME

FASTEST

Mr Frisk (1990) **8m 47.8s.**

SLOWEST

Officially, Lottery (1839) - **14m 53s.** Given the nature of the 1839 Grand National, it is meaningless to compare to subsequent times.

Between 1863, when the start was moved, and 1888, when the finishing line was altered, the race distance was different and times can only be meaningfully compared from 1888 onwards, when the distance was settled on four miles, 856 yards (it had previously been advertised as four and a half miles but was actually 30 yards short). The slowest time since 1888 was set by Red Marauder (2001), who won in 11m 0.1s.

The distance was cut to four miles three and a half furlongs between 2013 and 2015, so that the start could be moved 90 yards nearer to the first fence.

The race now takes place over four miles, two furlongs and 74 yards and has done so since 2016, following a new methodology being applied to the measurement of Jump courses in Britain.

The fastest time of the four runnings to date over the lesser distance is 9m 1.00s, set by Tiger Roll in 2019.

WEIGHTS

HIGHEST WINNING WEIGHT

12st 7lb carried by four winners to victory: Poethlyn (1919), Jerry M (1912), Manifesto (1899) and Cloister (1893).

This is a record that will not be broken as the top-weight was lowered to 12st in 1956, then went down to 11st 12lb in 2002 and 11st 10lb in 2009.

Since Poethlyn, only four horses have triumphed with 12st or more – Red Rum (12st in 1974), Reynoldstown (12st 2lb in 1936), Golden Miller (12st 2lb in 1934) and Sprig (12st 4lb in 1927).

LOWEST WINNING WEIGHT

9st 6lb was carried by Freetrader in 1856. The minimum weight now is 10st, regardless whether a horse's rating merits less (termed "racing from out of the handicap"). The Randox Health Grand National's popularity in recent years has seen few entries, if any, from out of the handicap make the final field.

WEIGHTS

SPECIAL DISCRETION

The Radox Health Grand National is the only race where the official handicapper specially frames the weights, often taking into account past Aintree form.

The weights are announced at a launch in Liverpool (February 11, 2020) and do not change afterwards as there are no penalties for success subsequently.

British Horseracing Authority chase handicapper Martin Greenwood took over responsibility for framing the Grand National weights in 2019 from Phil Smith, who retired in July, 2018, after being responsible for the weights between 1999 and 2018.

Smith encouraged the best horses to take part in the Grand National by compressing the weights at the top of the handicap since 2001 - giving them a more lenient mark than their official rating, mainly because of the race's long distance.

He was rewarded with the closest finish in Grand National history in 2012 when Neptune Collonges defied 11st 6lb to beat Sunyhillboy by a nose.

Many Clouds, the 2015 Grand National winner, carried 11st 9lb, the highest victorious weight since Red Rum's 12st in 1974.

WINNING DISTANCES

SHORTEST WINNING DISTANCE

Neptune Collonges won by **a nose** from Sunnyhillboy in 2012. A nose was introduced into British racing on February 25, 2008 to provide a more accurate measurement between a short-head and a dead-heat.

The 1865 winner Alicbiade beat the runner-up Hall Court by what was as described as "the shortest of heads". Finch Mason's painting of the finish suggests it would have been the equivalent of a nose today.

FURTHEST WINNING DISTANCE

A distance - Cloister (1893), Covertcoat (1913), Shaun Spadah (1921), Tipperary Tim (1928), Mr What (1958) and Red Marauder (2001).

A distance is a measure denoting anything more than 30 lengths.

JOCKEY FACTS

MOST WINS

George Stevens is the winning-most jockey in Grand National history with **five successes** - Freetrader (1856), Emblem (1863), Emblematic (1864) and The Colonel (1869 and 1870).

YOUNGEST

The youngest jockey to win the Grand National was **17-year-old** Bruce Hobbs on Battleship in 1938. He had his first ride in the race the year before at the age of 16 after turning professional. He went on to be a successful trainer on the Flat, mostly based in Newmarket, with his biggest success coming in the 1980 Irish Derby with Tyrnavos.

OLDEST

The oldest rider to capture the Grand National was **48-year-old** amateur Dick Saunders on Grittar in 1982, his first and only ride in the race - he retired from race riding immediately afterwards.

CURRENT JOCKEYS

Leighton Aspell and Davy Russell hold the best record of current jockeys, having won the Radox Health Grand National twice.

Aspell became the first jockey since Brian Fletcher (Red Rum) in 1974 to win consecutive Grand Nationals, thanks to Pineau De Re (2014) and Many Clouds (2015), a feat Russell repeated on Tiger Roll in 2018 and 2019.

Aspell was also the first jockey to ride successive Grand National winners on different horses since Bryan Marshall in 1954 (Royal Tan that year & Early Mist 1953).

MOST RIDES

Richard Johnson has ridden in the Grand National a record **21 times**, coming closest to victory with second place finishes on What's Up Boys in 2002 & Balthazar King in 2014.

Other champion jockeys have tried and failed to win the Grand National, including eight-time champion Peter Scudamore, who did best from 12 rides when third in 1985 on Corbiere, and seven-time champion John Francome, who went closest twice on Rough And Tumble - third in 1979 and second the following year.

Another champion, Jonjo O'Neill, had eight Grand National rides but never once completed the course. However, he went to train the 2010 winner Don't Push It.

MCCOY RECORD

Sir A P McCoy, who retired following a record-breaking career which included his 20th consecutive British champion Jump jockey title, in April, 2015, rode in the Grand National 20 times between 1995 and 2015.

McCoy had to wait until his 15th ride in the Grand National - on Don't Push It in 2010 - for success. He was awarded an OBE in the Queen's Birthday Honours List in June, 2010, voted the 2010 BBC Sports Personality of the Year and knighted following his retirement in 2015.

Algy Anthony – rode 1900 Ambush II; trained 1900 Ambush II & 1920 Troytown.

Aubrey Hastings – rode 1906 Ascetic's Silver; trained 1906 Ascetic's Silver, 1915 Ally Sloper & 1924 Master Robert.

Fulke Walwyn – rode 1936 Reynoldstown; trained 1964 Team Spirit.

Fred Winter – rode 1957 Sundew & 1962 Kilmore; trained 1965 Jay Trump & 1966 Anglo.

Tommy Carberry – rode 1975 L'Escargot; trained 1999 Bobbyjo.

SPRING DOUBLE

Following the Lincoln Handicap run on the Flat at Doncaster, the Radox Health Grand National forms leg two of the 'Spring Double'. The only jockey to have won both contests is Dave Dick, who captured the Lincoln on Gloaming in 1941 and the Grand National on E.S.B. in 1956.

AMATEUR RIDERS

In the 172 runnings of the Grand National at Aintree, 41 have been won by amateur riders. Many of the top riders in the early days of Jump racing were non-professional and 27 19th century Grand Nationals went to amateurs.

FIRST AMATEUR WINNER

Mr Bartholomew Bretherton, aboard Jerry in 1840.

MOST RECENT AMATEUR WINNER

Marcus Armytage on 16/1 chance Mr Frisk, trained by Kim Bailey for American owner Lois Duffey, in a record time on fast ground in 1990. Armytage is racing correspondent of The Daily Telegraph.

His sister Gee Armytage, a professional at the time, rode Gee-A in the 1988 Grand National, pulling up before the 26th fence.

MOST RECENT AMATEUR PLACING

Jamie Codd finished second on Cause Of Causes in 2017.

MOST SUCCESSFUL RIDER OVER GRAND NATIONAL FENCES

Sam Waley-Cohen, with six wins over the Grand National fences, is the most successful current rider over the Grand National fences. Annually, five races take place over the Grand National fences at Aintree Racecourse.

Amateur rider Waley-Cohen finished second on Oscar Time in the 2011 Grand National and finished fourth on the same horse two years later among his eight rides so far. His victories over the famous fences include back-to-back successes on Katarino in the 2005 and 2006 Fox Hunters' Chases. In the latter year, uniquely he won two races over the big obstacles during the Grand National Festival, also capturing the Topham Chase on Liberthine. His tally over the unique fences is completed by Warne in the 2014 Fox Hunters', Oscar Time in the 2014 Becher Chase and Rajdhani Express in the 2015 Topham Chase.

OLDEST WINNER

Amateur Dick Saunders aged 48 on Grittar in 1982 on his first and only ride.

OLDEST TO COMPLETE

American amateur Tim Durant was 68 when 15th on Highlandie in 1968 after he remounted at Becher's second time.

QUALIFIED TO RIDE

Since 2012, any jockey - amateur or professional - riding in the Grand National must have partnered at least 10 winners over fences and a minimum of 15 winners in total over hurdles and chases.

Five successful trainers since 1900 also rode Grand National winners as well - Algy Anthony, Tommy Carberry, Aubrey Hastings, Fulke Walwyn and Fred Winter.

Fred Winter is the only person to have won the Cheltenham Gold Cup, Champion Hurdle and Grand National as both a trainer and a jockey. He trained two Grand National winners - Jay Trump (1965) and Anglo (1966) - and partnered two victors, Sundew (1957) and Kilmore (1962) - during a tremendous career.

Rubstic, trained by John Leadbetter in Roxburghshire, was the first Scottish-trained winner in 1979. One For Arthur became the second successful horse to be trained in Scotland, when scoring for Kinross handler Lucinda Russell in 2017. The only Welsh-trained horse to win was Kirkland in 1905.

Two French-trained horses have won the Grand National, Huntsman (1862) and Cortolvin (1867). Both were trained in Chantilly by Yorkshireman Harry Lamplugh, who also rode Huntsman to victory.

Gordon Elliott (3 wins) and Nigel Twiston-Davies (2 wins) are the only current trainers to have won the Grand National more than once.
