# Welcome



We are delighted that you have entered your horse to run at Aintree and we look forward to welcoming you.

## Pre- Arrival

**Please register your attendance through our new Owners' Booking System. Please do not use the PASS system for this meeting.**

The lead owner registered at Weatherbys will receive a **unique access email and code** with an entry letter. This code allows the lead owner to use the booking system **once only** and bookings are only valid for declared runners.

All attendees must be registered by **3:00pm the day before racing**. When completing the booking:

- Enter **the full names of every individual** who will attend the race meeting.
- Ensure you **include your own name** as an attendee.
- **Please do not** register multiple guests under the same name - each guest must be listed separately.

Please note: **Badges are non-transferable & children under 18** do not require a badge.

We ask **syndicate managers and trainers** to share this Owners' Information Brochure with their members so that everyone is aware of the requirements. Syndicate managers and trainers are authorised to enter attendee details into the Owners' Booking System on behalf of their members.

**Single ownership - Eight badges & eight meal vouchers.**

**Partnerships & Syndicates - Eight badges & eight meal vouchers.**

Subject to availability additional badges can be purchased on the day at the half price rate of £12.50, as well as meal vouchers at £25 per person.

### Large Syndicates

We recognise that ownership takes many different forms, and we aim to accommodate the needs of larger groups. Syndicates and racing clubs may choose to **exchange their complimentary lunches for up to 20 admission tickets** to the racecourse and the syndicate lounge. If preferred, **meal vouchers can be purchased separately** by syndicate members. Up to 20 should also provide access to the Parade Ring, subject to declaration numbers. Please ensure this arrangement is **clearly communicated to all syndicate members prior to arrival**. Additional general admission tickets will also be available to purchase for large syndicates at the reduced rate of £12.50 each.

Our **Syndicate Lounge – the Red Rum Bar**, located on the ground floor of the Earl of Derby Grandstand, will be available to **all owners, including syndicate members**, throughout the day.

# Arrival

## Sat Nav Postcode **L9 0LD**. What Three Words – **amused.kicked.truck**

Aintree Racecourse is located on the A59, just one mile from the M57 and M58, which link the M62 and M6. Follow the A59 to Liverpool and the yellow/tourism signs as you approach the racecourse for routes to the car parks.

### OWNERS' & TRAINERS' CAR PARK

**Please Note** - There is now a **new designated Car Park for Owners & Trainers**. Access to this car park is via the **Seeds Lane and Melling Road entrance**, which is the same entrance used for horseboxes. (Postcode provided above.) Upon arrival, please **present your digital car pass**, either as a printout or displayed on your phone. Our parking marshals will direct you to the appropriate parking area.

#### **Accessible Parking:**

Disabled parking spaces are available within the Owners & Trainers Car Park. Please ensure you bring your **Blue Badge**, and the parking stewards will guide you to the designated spaces on the day.

### TAXIS

If you are travelling by taxi, you may be dropped off at the **main entrance**, where an **Owners & Trainers ticket collection point** will be available.

For taxis before & after racing, we recommend **SRC Taxis (0151 928 3535)**. They can collect you from either the **Main Entrance** or the **Owners & Trainers Car Park** just off Seeds Lane.

### TRAIN

Merseyrail trains run between **Liverpool Central** and **Aintree Station** every 15 minutes. Aintree Station is located directly opposite the racecourse and is less than a five-minute walk away. For those arriving by train, an **Owners & Trainers ticket collection point** is available at the **main entrance** to the Racecourse.

### HELICOPTER

A designated area is available on the racecourse for helicopter landings. **Prior notice is required** for all arrivals to ensure appropriate landing arrangements and insurance indemnity. Please email **Carly Sage** at **Aintree.owners@thejockeyclub.co.uk** to confirm your plans.

Please note the following restrictions in accordance with air safety regulations, particularly regarding flights over built-up areas:

**No landings** are permitted **within 30 minutes before the first race**.

**No take-offs** are permitted **until 30 minutes after the last race**.

If you are arriving by helicopter, please notify Carly in advance so that your **badges will be ready for collection upon landing**.

## GATES OPEN AT 15.40pm

Once parked, please proceed to the **Owners' Entrance**, located by the entrance to the **Alan Lee Media Centre**, opposite the **Lord Sefton Grandstand**.

Please ensure you use the **Horsebox and Owners & Trainers Car Park** via **Seeds Lane / Melling Road**, not the Equestrian Centre car park. Stewards will be on hand to guide you.

To collect your badges, please present your **PASS card** or an acceptable **form of ID**.

Complimentary **tea and coffee** will be available on arrival, along with access to **toilets**, including accessible facilities, within the Owners & Trainers entrance area.

Please be aware that the **Owners & Trainers badge collection desk will close after the 4th race**.

## ACCESSIBILITY

Aintree Racecourse is committed to ensuring that all guests enjoy a welcoming, inclusive, and accessible experience.

In line with the Disability Discrimination Act (DDA), we place great importance on providing convenient access and appropriate facilities for visitors with disabilities, and we continually look for opportunities to enhance and improve our provisions.

While some of our buildings are older and feature varying floor levels, we work hard to ensure that all guests can access the racecourse with ease, and that key services and amenities are available close to entry points whenever full access is not structurally achievable. In recent years, significant investment and upgrades across the site, including modernisations completed as recently as 2008, have helped us improve our accessibility further.

To support our visitors, we have partnered with AccessAble to create a comprehensive Accessibility Guide, offering detailed, up-to-date information to help guests plan their day with confidence.

Owners & Trainers are invited to enjoy a complimentary two-course carvery dinner in the **Golden Miller Suite**, located on the **1st floor of the Earl of Derby Grandstand**, just a short distance from the Parade Ring & the badge collection entrance. The Golden Miller Restaurant is course facing, close to the finishing line with a fantastic view of the Racecourse. This area is exclusively for Owners who have runners with us on the day & who are dining with us. It includes a full bar and complimentary tea, coffee & soft drinks.

A delicious carvery buffet will be available until the fifth race, offering a range of freshly prepared options. Tables will be allocated on arrival, & we kindly request that during busy times guests vacate their table once they have finished their meal so that we can ensure everyone is able to dine comfortably throughout the day. There will be additional seating available by the bar area in the Golden Miller Suite as well as seating in the Red Rum Bar.

Please note that tables may be shared with Owners from other horses. If you feel you would like to dine later than the fifth race, please let a member of staff know so that we can make provisions. A wide range of food options is available on course, including choices that cater to common food intolerances, dietary requirements and a children's menu. Please speak to a member of our catering team for assistance.

Aintree Racecourse continues to operate on a **cashless basis** for hospitality and on-site purchases. Cash may still be used when placing bets on-course. **Large syndicates** have the option to forfeit their meal vouchers in exchange for additional admission badges. Syndicate members are also welcome to use the **Syndicate Lounge in the Red Rum Bar**, located on the ground floor of the Earl of Derby Grandstand. This bar is open to **all Owners** throughout the day with a full bar and complimentary tea, coffee & soft drinks.

# The Racing

## VIEWING THE RACING



Owners' and trainers' viewing areas are located on a dedicated area on the steps of the Lord Sefton Grandstand and on the balcony of the Golden Miller Suite within the Earl of Derby Grandstand. The Golden Miller Suite balcony is wheelchair accessible.

There are an adequate number of large screens throughout the grandstand, all of which are clearly visible from most viewing positions. There will also be a big screen on the racecourse which you can view from the Golden Miller Suite. Races from other fixtures will also be available to be viewed on the screens in the Owners facilities.

## PARADE RING AND WINNER'S ENCLOSURE

Owners will have access to the Parade Ring for the race in which they have a runner, in line with capacity calculation limits. Depending on the amount of runners in a particular race, on busier race days we may need to limit the number of owners and guests who can enter the parade ring for each runner.

The connections of the first four in each race are welcomed into the Winners Enclosure after the race.

## WINNING CONNECTIONS

Winning Connections will be invited by an Aintree Committee member into the Winners' Enclosure for the trophy presentation, followed by a celebratory glass of champagne in Freebooter where you can watch a replay of the race.

Syndicate owners are also welcome to join in the celebrations, provided they hold an Owners' badge or Syndicate Lounge wristband.

Owners fortunate enough to win a race on the day will receive a commemorative memento, an official photograph, and a DVD (TVinaCard) recording of the race. A winning rosette will be presented to the winning groom. Additional photos will be available to purchase from our Racecourse Photographer.

A digital copy of the winner's photograph will be emailed to the Syndicate Manager within a few days after racing, for them to share with Syndicate members.

Individual USB's of the race will be available to syndicate members on request.

## PLACED CONNECTIONS

Placed Connections will receive a champagne voucher, redeemable in either the Golden Miller Owners & Trainers Suite or the Red Rum Bar.

## TOILETS

During your visit, toilet facilities are conveniently located throughout the racecourse, with clear signage to help you find the nearest ones from all main areas, including the car parks, grandstands, and hospitality zones. Accessible toilets are also available for guests with disabilities.

Owners and Trainers toilet facilities are conveniently located opposite the main Owners and Trainers badge collection point, as well as in the Red Rum Bar and the Golden Miller Suite.

Our staff and stewards are on hand if you need any assistance in locating facilities, ensuring your visit is as comfortable as possible.

## WIFI

Aintree Racecourse offers free WiFi across the course. To connect, simply select “**Free Jockey Club WiFi**” on your smartphone, tablet, or laptop and follow the on-screen instructions.

## BETTING

Betting facilities are available during your visit, with a Tote facility located in the Golden Miller Suite, as well as onsite bookmakers situated in front of the Grandstands for your convenience.

Cash may be used when placing bets with the Tote and all on-course bookmakers.

All Tote positions also accept debit card payments, including Apple Pay and Google Pay. Please note that credit cards cannot be used for betting.
