Music Nights its 4 Tickets at an additional £30.00

ROA Days – if an owner doesn't have a horse running but wants to attend the races they can if they are an ROA member by using their pass card at the O+T desk. Please note that this only gets them General Admission entry and not Owners and Trainers.

### **Parking**

Owners and Trainers have their own car park situated on the right hand side of the North Car Park. Follow directions when you get to the course.

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION:

**By Road: From the north and south:** Leave M6 at junction 42, follow signs for Dalston. Follow the road for approx 2 miles until you reach a staggered junction and turn right. The racecourse is approximately 1 mile on the left hand side.

**From the east:** Take A69 or A66 to M6 motorway. Join the M6 and leave at junction 42 and follow directions above.

**From the west:** Travel along the A595 following signs for Carlisle. Approximately 1 mile after Thursby roundabout, take right signposted for Dalston (Peter Lane). At T-junction in Dalston turn right. Follow road until you reach Bridge End pub. Turn left over the bridge and follow signs for Durdar. When you reach the next junction, turn left. The racecourse is approximately a mile on the left hand side.

**By bus:** On raceday's, Reays operate a bus service from Carlisle Bus Station to the Racecourse. Buses run 90 minutes and 45 minutes before the first race and return to Carlisle 5 minutes and 35 minutes after the last race. The cost for this service is £1.60 each way. On non-racedays, the timetable for the bus serving the racecourse can be found by following the below link. Ask your bus driver which stop to get off at for the Racecourse! **By train:** The racecourse is 2.2 miles from Carlisle Station, a major station on the West Coast Main Line, lying 102 miles south of Glasgow Central, and 299 miles north of London

Euston. Stagecoach (01228 597222) operate a bus service to Durdar – Route 65 or 66. Alternatively the racecourse is only a short taxi ride or a slightly longer walk away. **By air:** Carlisle Airport is approximately eight miles from the Racecourse.
