

#### THE BETFAIR SPRINT CUP



#### The Betfair Sprint Cup is the highlight of the Flat season at Haydock Park and the Group 1 contest over six furlongs is run for the 54th time.

The inaugural running was held on 5th November 1966, and fell to Be Friendly, trained in Epsom by Cyril Mitchell and owned by the BBC's "Voice of Racing" Sir Peter O'Sullevan. Be Friendly was victorious once again in 1967 and remains the only dual victor to date.

Last year saw Hello Youmzain come out on top for Kevin Ryan, a switch to forcing tactics under James Doyle working a treat as he held off the 2018-winner The Tin Man. He was the sixth three-year-old to win the race since 2010.

#### **Youngest Winners:**

Be Friendly (1966) and The Blues (1973) were both two-year-olds. The race is now restricted to three-year-olds and upwards.

Boldboy (1977) and Markab (2010) were both seven when successful.




#### **VETS SCREEN POLICY**
