Haydock Park boasts a purpose-built accommodation block with individual rooms to ensure that stable staff have a pleasant stay. Due to the size of The Lodge, we cannot accommodate all staff onsite during busy fixtures, however, we have built a string relationship with a local 4* hotel where we will provide staff with single occupancy rooms.

We aim to accommodate all reasonable requests from staff and operate an anonymous feedback process in The Lodge so we can ensure that we are meeting the expectations of stable staff.

Under 18's cannot be accommodated at The Lodge or Mercure Hotel.

The Lodge at Haydock Park

Number of rooms? There are 13 ensuite bedrooms, with a small number of rooms that can double up as a sharing room. Each bedroom boasts a modern, fresh and relaxing décor.

Who stays at The Lodge: Racing Staff. At peak times during the flat season, senior head-staff may request to stay on-site. Whilst every effort to support your request is made, at times we will need to use alternative accommodation. During the Jump season accommodation is allocated on first come first serve basis. The Lodge is specifically servicing Racing Staff and regrettably cannot be used by Owners or Trainers.

Where is The Lodge? Situated beside the Racecourse Stables and Horsebox Car Park.

How do we book a room? Submit an accommodation booking form to haydockpark.stables@thejockeyclub.co.uk

Will someone be there to check me in? Our friendly team are on hand 24 hours a day to help with anything you require, check in is from anytime you request, through until check out by 10.00am on the day of departure.

Refreshments: Light breakfast options, tea, coffee and milk are available in the Racing Staff restaurant, and Tea and Coffee facilities are available in each room. During racing, a full complement of hot food options are available.

Get Connected: Free Jockey Club Wi-Fi is available in The Lodge.

Facilities: Each room has a LG Smart TV, hairdryer, hanging rails, towels and fresh bedding. Should staff be on site for more than 24 hours our cleaners will be happy to service their room should they leave a sign to indicate this on their door by 10am.

Pets are not allowed except for assistant dogs.

Accessible rooms are provided upon request.

Frequently asked questions

The Mercure

Number of rooms? A small number of rooms are allocated to Racing Staff in case The Lodge is fully booked at the 4 Star Mercure Haydock Hotel.

Where is The Mercure? A 10-minute walk from the racecourse, just a mile away from the stable yard. A regular shuttle bus will be in place to transport staff between the racecourse and hotel.

How do we book a room? Request rooms by 1pm on the day of declarations by emailing haydockpark.stables@thejockeyclub.co.uk

Will someone be there to check me in? There is a 24-hour check in desk.

Refreshments: Light breakfast options, tea, coffee and milk are available in the Racing Staff restaurant, and Tea and Coffee facilities are available in each room. During racing, a full complement of hot food options is available.

Transportation: Haydock Park provide a free shuttle service; Racing Staff should make arrangements with the shuttle driver at the time of their stay. A mobile number for our minibus driver will be provided upon arrival.

The Stables

How many stables are available? 124 stables, allocated according to declarations and the discretion of the Racecourse Stable Manager.

Bedding: Paper, with a small number of shaving stables available. Two bales per stable, additional bales available upon request.

Traveller, Pony and companion: The vast majority are welcomed if they comply with the BHA vaccination code, we ask you to notify us on the day of declaration, however if the stables are fully booked Haydock Park Racecourse accommodates runners first.

Exercising: Use of the sand canter down at the time allotted by the CofC or Head Groundsman. Use of the track is not permitted.
