### DINING

As part of Newmarket Racecourses' commitment to providing an outstanding Owners and Trainers experience, our two-course complementary meal offer is in place at all 39 racedays this season.

Bookings for the Runners Lounge will be taken from the 48hr declaration stage up until 5pm the evening prior to racing. Bookings can be made via the email address below, or alternatively you can make your booking by telephone.

A maximum of six meal allocations will be issued per ownership. Additional meals may be available for purchase (£20 each) subject to availability.

### BADGE ALLOCATION

If your horse is declared to run, you will be able to collect your badges from the Owners and Trainers desk in the Premier Entrance 1.

#### Sole Owners

If you are a sole owner of a horse declared to run, you are entitled to 6 complimentary badges and 6 complimentary meals. Up to a further 10 badges can be purchased at half the price of the standard charge (excluding music/sell-out events). If you are leaving your badges for guests please confirm the names with Anna Metekohy in advance of the raceday or via PASS.

#### Joint Owners

If you are a joint owner of a horse declared to run, you are entitled to 8 complimentary badges and 6 complimentary meals. Up to a further 10 badges can be purchased at half the price of the standard charge (excluding music/sell-out events). If you are leaving your badges for guests please confirm the names with Anna Metekohy in advance of the raceday or via PASS.

## Syndicate

If you are the member of a syndicate, the group is entitled to 10 complimentary badges and 6 complimentary meals. Up to a further 10 badges can be purchased at half the price of the standard charge (**excluding music events/sell-out events**). Badges should be individually allocated to members by the Syndicate Manager and confirmed with the Anna Metekohy in advance of the raceday.

## OWNERS FACILITIES

Our exclusive Owners and Trainers bar is located at the end of the pre-parade ring, nearest to the Grandstand. Enjoy a complimentary tea or coffee whilst watching the racing on screen or make the most of the secluded seating area outside providing a stunning view of the pre-parade ring.

Race viewing for Owners and Trainers is located in the Head on Stand.

Connections with runners on the day have access to the Runners Lounge which is located in one of our exclusive Paddock Pavilions, overlooking the beautiful parade ring and conveniently positioned to access all areas of the racecourse. A two course-seasonal buffet lunch will be served here on race days as well as complementary tea, coffee and water. A bar is also available.

## ADDITIONAL HOSPITALITY

There are a limited number of tables in the Summer House Restaurant that are reserved for Owners with runners. They will be held until 11am the day prior to racing and then released to the general public. They can be booked on a first come, first served basis, subject to availability. We also have exclusive Trackside Pavilions available with the added comfort of your own decking to bring you even closer to the action, again these are subject to availability. ### PARADE RING SAFETY

Regrettably no children under the age of 12 are permitted in the parade ring or winners enclosure. Children between the ages of 12 and 16 may do so but must be accompanied by an adult and must have the permission of Michael Prosser, Clerk of the Course. This is a Health & Safety requirement and is covered by the Rules of Racing.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE JULY COURSE

The A11 and A14 provide easy access from the major cities of East Anglia and from the M11 and A1 / M1 respectively.

#### **If you are travelling along the M11 from London please use the following directions:**

Merge onto the A11 at junction 9, signposted Newmarket and Norwich.

After 10 miles branch left and merge onto the A1304, signposted Newmarket.

After 5 miles take the second exit at the roundabout, signposted The July Course.

### PARKING

Owners and Trainers with a horse running on the day are permitted to park in the Owners and Trainers and Annual Badge Holders Car Park.

### PARKING LABELS

Your parking label will be attached to the email at declaration stage. We ask that you do not print more than two copies of this label as there is limited space available in the Owners and Trainers car park.

### ACCESSIBLE PARKING

We have dedicated blue badge parking in both the Premier and Public car parks. If you require assistance from your car, our car park attendants will be able to radio for the shuttle buggy which will take you to the point of entry.

### RAIL

If you are planning to come by train, we have a shuttle bus running at regular intervals between Newmarket Train Station and the racecourse.

### AIR

Stansted Airport is a 35 minute drive from Newmarket Racecourses and it is only a 15 minute drive to Cambridge Airport.
