

Annual Membership 2020 Reciprocal Dates

Sandown Park Annual Members benefit from access to a number of reciprocal race fixtures around the country for 2020. Where possible we have given you the information on what you can access at each course.

Please note that all dates are subject to change and we recommend checking with the course prior to arrival to avoid any disappointment.

January:

Wetherby - Saturday 11th January 2020

- Access to the Paddock Enclosure and Premier Enclosure facilities. Due to limited capacity no access to the Annual Badge Holder Suite.
- Parking is in the free public parking areas but no reserved parking.
- Gain access to the Racecourse using your annual badge, via the main entrance at the designated Annual Badge Holder turnstile.
- There is not a formal dress code in any of the enclosures, however they do advise that you dress in smart casual attire.

February:

Market Rasen - Tuesday 4th February 2020:

- Access all three of their enclosures. Due to limited capacity no access to the Limber Hill Bar
- Please use the County Entrance. Entrance through Owners & Trainers will not be permitted.
- Please use the County Car Park.
- All reciprocal members are entitled to book a space in the Altiors restaurant pending availability, please call the racecourse office to do this: 01673 843434.
- A smart casual code is applicable for the County Enclosure. Men must wear collared shirts and trousers or smart jeans (ties not essential) (No ripped or faded denim). No shorts, sportswear or trainers.

Bangor on Dee - Friday 7th February 2020

- No access to members bar or members car park at Bangor on Dee.
- Parking is available free in normal car park areas.

March:

Plumpton - Monday 9th March 2020

- Due to limited space, you do not have access to the Annual Members facilities or car park, however, all car parking is free at Plumpton.
- Racecards can be purchased for £2 each.
- As they race primarily through the winter months, they recommend you check the weather forecast to ensure you are appropriately dressed. However, if you are dining in the Paddock or Marquee restaurant, the dress code is Smart/Casual and smart jeans are permitted.

<u>Huntingdon - Wednesday 11th March 2020</u>

- Dress code is smart casual no ripped denim or any logo or football/sporting t- shirts.
- Please park in the main car park as there is no access to the Huntingdon Annual Members cark park or members bar (Cromwell Suite) due to space restriction.

<u>Fakenham - Friday 13th March 2020</u>

- Access to all enclosures.
- Parking is in the centre of the racecourse. If you wish to park in the Members Car Park a fee of £8.00 per vehicle is applicable.
- The dress code is smart casual.

Newbury - Friday 20th March 2020

- Free car parking.
- Access to Premier Enclosure but not the Annual Member's Bar.
- Encouraged to wear smart attire, gentleman to wear collared shirts (no tie). Smart denim with no rips or tears are acceptable. No sports/denim shorts, t-shirts, vests, sportswear (including trainers), supporter shirts, tracksuits, or bare chests. Gentleman's flip flops/ sandals are not permitted.

Stratford - Saturday 28th March 2020

- Access to Club enclosures & use of car parks.
- Unfortunately no access to Annual Members' Tea Room

April:

Wincanton - Wednesday 1st April 2020

- Use of the Annual Members' car park.
- Due to limited capacity you are unable to access the Premier Viewing Area or the Annual Members Lounge.

Newton Abbot - Saturday 11th April 2020

- Car parking is in the centre of the course and is free Due to limited capacity you are unable to use the member's car park. Disabled parking is nearside. Parking is free.
- Access will be to the Course and Paddock Enclosures.
- There is no strict dress code unless dining in their restaurants.
- Visiting members can use the Annual Members Lounge which is next door to the Owners and Trainers Bar if space permits on the day.

<u>Lingfield Park - Tuesday 14th April 2020</u>

- Access to all public areas but not the annual members bar.
- Free parking in the main public car park.

<u>Cheltenham - Thursday 16th April 2020</u>

- Access to the Club and Tattersalls enclosures. There is no access to the member's facilities.
- Parking is free of charge and is located in the Green parking zone. Please follow the Green route when approaching the course.

<u>Fontwell Park - Friday 17th April 2020</u>

- Access to both the Paddock and Premier enclosures. Due to limited capacity, there is no access to the members' room.
- £10 off per head for premier restaurant bookings.
- Members are encouraged to park in the free car park (postcode: BN18 OSX) Limited number of spaces in the centre course- charged at £5.
- In the Premier enclosure there is a smart casual dress code jeans are acceptable as long as they're not ripped etc. The Paddock enclosure has no dress code.

Epsom Downs - Wednesday 22nd April 2020

- Access to both the Queen's Stand and the Duchess's Stand.
- Free car parking in car parks 3, 6 & 7.

Windsor - Monday 27th April 2020

• Use of the Annual Members' car park but due to limited capacity there is no access to the Annual Members Enclosure and bar.

<u>Punchestown - Tuesday 28th April 2020</u>

- Free parking available in the general car park.
- Access to the general enclosure and the reserved enclosure. Also access to all bars except the Punchestown Members Bar due to limited capacity.
- Dress code is smart casual

May:

Musselburgh - Friday 1st May 2020

- Please use Entrance 2, The Links Pavilion where you will be admitted to the course.
- Unfortunately there is no access to the Annual Members Bar.
- There is a free car park, located at the top of Balcarres Road a 5 minute walk to the Racecourse entrance.
- There is no strict dress code, however visitors are encouraged to dress for the weather.

<u>Kempton Park - Monday 4th May 2020</u>

- Free parking in the main car park upon showing membership badge.
- Unfortunately no access to the members lounge.
- Dress code is smart casual with no ripped denim or any logo or football/sporting t- shirts.

Bath - Friday 8th May 2020

- Car parking is free and plentiful. If you wish to leave your car overnight, please inform the parking stewards on your arrival and be aware that this is done so at your own risk.
- There is a smart casual dress code. Smart denim and tailored shorts are acceptable whilst denim with rips or tears, denim shorts and sportswear are discouraged.
- No access to the Roof Garden but if there is availability on the day they offer an upgrade price from as little as £9 per person.

<u>Killarney - Sunday 10th May 2020</u>

- Entry to all enclosures bar hospitality
- Free car parking
- Access to the Race goers Club Bar
- Dress code smart/casual

<u>Leicester - Monday 18th May 2020</u>

- Access into the Grandstand & Premier stand.
- Car parking is free of charge.

Warwick - Wednesday 20th May 2020

- There is only one enclosure so you will have access to all public areas.
- Parking is free in the centre of the course

Hampshire County Cricket Club - Friday 22nd May 2020

- Hampshire v Lancashire Day 1
- Members have access to the Derek Shackleton Suite and car parking is available in advance for £8.00 or on the day for £10.00 located on site.

Newmarket (Rowley Mile) - Saturday 30th May 2020

- You must register at the Free Pass Office so they are able to monitor how many visitors we have on site. This is located at the Grandstand and Paddock Entrance (located next to the turnstiles, adjacent to the free car park)
- Access will be granted into the Premier Enclosure, however due to limited capacity there is no access to the annual badge holder's facilities or car park.
- There is a smart/casual dress code: No trainers, t-shirts, sports attire or extreme attire are permitted.
- Car parking is free in the free car park.

June:

<u>Doncaster - Friday 5th June 2020</u>

- Access to the County stand which includes access to the Winning Post and the Parade Ring, the Pre-Parade Ring & Saddling Boxes and access to the ground, 1st and 2nd floors of the main stand. Guests will also be able to go over to the Champagne Lawn which is home to The Old Weighing Room Restaurant which will be open on most fixtures.
- Car parking is available in car park A which is located directly opposite the course and priced at £5 per vehicle. Alternately you can park in car park C which is free of charge but is a slight walk to the course. All car parks are sign posted from surrounding roads.

<u>Cowdray Park - Sunday 7th June 2020: Final of the Duke of Sutherland Cup</u>

- Parking in members car park
- Use of the clubhouse

<u>Salisbury - Tuesday 9th Ju</u>ne 2020

- Access to the Bibury Enclosure access.
- Please use the Bibury or Grandstand entrances. Entrance through Owners & Trainers will not be permitted.
- All car parking is free we recommend using car park 2. You are not permitted to use Car Park 1 (for annual subscribers) due to space constraints
- A smart casual dress code is applicable for the Bibury Enclosure. Men must wear collared shirts and smart trousers or tailored shorts (ties not essential) Smart Jeans are accepted (No ripped or faded denim). No sportswear.

Uttoxeter - Wednesday 17th June 2020

- Car parking is free of charge and you may park in the annual member's car park with your car park passes.
- There will be no access to the annual members bar but your badge gives you Premier access to all of the enclosures.

<u>Brighton - Tuesday 23rd June 2020</u>

- Free car parking is available in the main car park at the front of the course.
- Entry is for both the Grandstand & Paddock and Premier enclosures. Unfortunately, due to limited capacity, there is no access to the Annual Members lounge.
- There is not a strict dress code but they recommend smart casual dress at all meetings and encourage everyone to dress to impress at feature fixture dates!
- You are welcome to book tables in the Silks Restaurant by calling the racing team on 01273 603 580 prior to your visit.
- Gate opening and race times, together with details of our restaurant and hospitality packages, can be found via their website: brightonracecourse.co.uk

Hamilton Park - Thursday 25th June 2020

• Access to all areas excluding hospitality & members areas.

Hickstead - Friday 26th June 2020

- Full access to the Showground, member's car parking, seating in the members grandstand and full use of the restaurant and bar facilities.
- There is a smart casual dress code in the members with no beachwear allowed.

Pontefract - Monday 29th June 2020

- Access to the Premier Enclosure. There is no access to Annual Badge holder's Bar.
- Free car parking in the designated areas.
- Smart casual dress code No ripped jeans, shorts or sportswear.

July:

Windsor - Monday 6th July 2020

• Use of the Annual Members' car park but due to limited capacity unfortunately no use of the Annual Members Enclosure and bar.

Ffos Las - Friday 10th July 2020

- Access to the main bar area but due to limited capacity no access to the members bar. They do not offer a viewing box option.
- Car parking is free and there are no parking restrictions at the racecourse.

Ripon - Saturday 18th July 2020

- Due to limited capacity, there is no access to the Annual Badge Holders Bar.
- To reserve a table in the Club Restaurant please contact Becky Peters at their caterers, CGC Events, on 0113 287 6387.
- The dress code for the Club Enclosure is smart/casual ie no sportswear, trainers, t-shirts, casual shorts or polo shirts. Gentlemen are asked to wear a smart collared shirt and trousers. Smart denim is allowed (i.e. it must not be ripped, torn or frayed).

Hampshire County Cricket Club - 19th July 2020

- Hampshire v Worcester Royal London One-Day Cup
- Members have access to the Derek Shackleton Suite and car parking is available in advance for £8.00 or on the day for £10.00 located on site.

Hickstead - Sunday 26th July 2020

- Full access to the Showground, member's car parking, seating in the members grandstand and full use of the restaurant and bar facilities.
- There is a smart casual dress code in the members with no beachwear allowed.

August:

<u>Thirsk - Friday 14th August 2020</u>

- You can park in the Premier car park and enter through the Premier Entrance reporting to the desk on the left hand side.
- Access is available to all facilities apart from the Owners & Trainers and unfortunately the Annual Members bar due to limited capacity.
- The dress code is smart casual gentlemen are expected to wear a collared shirt but ties are not mandatory. Smart trousers or really smart dark jeans with shoes no trainers nor sportswear.

Chepstow - Thursday 20th August 2020

- Parking is free in the main public car park.
- Access to public areas, including Premier facilities on two-enclosure racedays. No access to the Annual Members Bar.
- Dress code is sensible and weather appropriate.

Brighton - Monday 24th August 2020

- Free car parking is available in the main car park at the front of the course.
- Entry is for both the Grandstand & Paddock and Premier enclosures. Unfortunately, due to limited capacity, there is no access to the Annual Members lounge.

- There is not a strict dress code but would recommend smart casual dress at all meetings and encourage everyone to dress to impress at feature fixture dates!
- You are welcome to book tables in the Silks Restaurant by calling the racing team on 01273 603 580 prior to your visit.
- Gate opening and race times, together with details of our restaurant and hospitality packages, can be found via our website: brightonracecourse.co.uk

Carlisle - Thursday 27th August 2020

- Access to the dedicated 365 Annual Members Bar where there is complimentary tea & coffee.
- Please check with the course if you are able to access the Patterson Bar on this specific day
- Access to all of the facilities on the ground floor that the general public has access to.
- Parking is free across the road from the main grandstand. Trackside parking is now available but must be booked before 5pm the day before by calling the racecourse office. You cannot turn up on the day to pay.

Newmarket (July Course) - Friday 28th August 2020

- You must register at the Free Pass Office so they are able to monitor how many visitors they have on site. The Free Pass Office is located at the Premier Entrance 2 (next to the first set of turnstiles adjacent to the free car park).
- Access will be granted into the Premier Enclosure, however due to limited capacity there is no access to the annual badge holders facilities or car park.
- There is a smart casual dress code: No trainers, t-shirts, sports attire or extreme attire are permitted.
- Car parking is free in the free car park.

Great Yarmouth - Sunday 30th August 2020

- Access to Grandstand, Paddock & Premier enclosures
- Parking In the main car park
- Dress code is smart casual, no torn or ripped jeans, beachwear, sportswear or extreme clothing. Shorts can be worn providing that they are tailored and smart footwear.

Epsom Downs - Monday 31st August 2020

- Access to both the Queen's Stand and the Duchess's Stand.
- Free car parking in car parks 3, 6 & 7.

September:

Ascot - Saturday 5th September 2020

- Parking in car park one or car park two when you arrive with your Sandown Park car park label, then proceed to one of the ticket offices and collect an entry ticket into the Racecourse
- Sandown Park metal badge will give entry to The King Edward V11 Enclosure (Level 4).

<u>Catterick - Tuesday 8th September 2020</u>

- Access to the Members viewing facility, subject to this facility being open on the day.
- Complimentary car parking in the car parks across from the main Grandstand.

Worcester - Monday 14th September 2020

- Parking in the free car park accessed via Severn Terrace & through the public pay & display car park.
- Unfortunately no access to the members bar.

Beverley - Tuesday 22nd September 2020

- Access to the Premier, Grandstand and Paddock and Course Enclosure. The only area with no access is the Annual Badgeholders Bar.
- There is one car park opposite the grandstand which is free.
- Dress code is only for the Premier Enclosure. Smart casual for both ladies and gentleman. Collared shirt, smart jeans are allowed, no sportswear or training shoes will be permitted into the enclosure.

Goodwood - Wednesday 23rd September 2020

- Access to our Members' Enclosure, the Richmond Enclosure.
- Anyone deemed to be dressed inappropriately will not be admitted to the Richmond Enclosure. The dress code is as follows:
 - All jeans, shorts, trainers and fancy dress are not permitted
 - Gentlemen are required to wear jackets and either a tie, cravat or polo neck sweater at all race meetings.
 - Ladies should dress smartly. High heels are not recommended due to the terrain and use of decking.
 - Children must be dressed smartly. Boys aged 16 + are required to follow the dress code for gentlemen. Boys under 16 are kindly requested to wear a collared shirt.
- No access to the Annual Members' Bar
- Parking is free in No 8 car park, you will just need to show your badge or card to gain entry.

Newcastle - Friday 25th September 2020

- Access to The Premier Enclosure or One Enclosure (Premier and Grandstand joined together).
- Dress code for Premier is smart casual, jeans are permitted as long as they are smart jeans, not ripped. Gentlemen are required to wear a shirt

- with a collar. No trainers or sportswear are permitted. There is no dress code when it is a One Enclosure fixture.
- Due to limited capacity there is no access to the Annual Members bar.
- Car Parking is free of charge at Newcastle.

<u>Epsom Downs - Sunday 27th September 2020</u>

- Access to both the Queen's Stand and the Duchess's Stand.
- Free car parking in car parks 3, 6 & 7.

October:

Southwell - Thursday 1st October 2020

- Parking is free in Car Park B
- Report to the Owners and Trainers desk inside the main entrance where you will collect a ticket for the days racing.
- The Seasons Restaurant is in the Premier area, pre-booking and payment is advised to avoid disappointment on the day.

Exeter - Tuesday 20th October 2020

- Access to the Haldon Premier and Grandstand & Paddock enclosures. No access to the member's room.
- There is no formal dress code but they do encourage smart casual attire as well as to dress for the weather.
- Parking is free and is located in the centre of the course.

Wincanton - Sunday 25th October 2020

- Use of the Annual Members' car park.
- Due to limited capacity you are unable to access the Premier Viewing Area or the Annual Members Lounge.

Kempton Park - Wednesday 28th October 2020

- Free parking in the main car park upon showing membership badge.
- Unfortunately no access to the members lounge.
- Dress code is smart casual with no ripped denim or any logo or football/sporting t- shirts.

November:

<u>Chelmsford City - Thursday 5th November 2020</u>

- Car parking is free and plentiful. Please use the main car park which can be accessed via the A131.
- Access to the Grandstand
- Smart casual dress code more details can be found on the website
- If you would like to upgrade to the restaurant, please call the office on 01245 360300 in advance and you will receive the members discount rate (subject to availability)

<u>Punchestown - Saturday 14th November 2020</u>

- Free parking available in the general car park.
- Access to the general enclosure and the reserved enclosure. Also access to all bars except the Members Bar due to limited capacity.
- Dress code is smart casual

Punchestown – Sunday 15th November 2020

- Free parking available in the general car park.
- Access to the general enclosure and the reserved enclosure. Also access to all bars except the Members Bar due to limited capacity.
- Dress code is smart casual

<u>Kempton Park - Monday 23rd November 2020</u>

- Free parking in the main car park upon showing membership badge.
- Unfortunately no access to the members lounge.
- Dress code is smart casual with no ripped denim or any logo or football/sporting t- shirts.

Wolverhampton - Saturday 28th November 2020

• Premier admission (or suitable alternative if privately hired) with access to the 1st floor Premier Suite and free car parking.

December:

<u>Taunton - Thursday 10th December 2020</u>

- Free parking in the Members car park.

- Should you wish to book a table in the restaurant you should call the racecourse in advance.
- There is no dress code but they suggest that racegoers dress smartly and for the weather.

- Access to the County enclosure. Unfortunately no access to Annual Members bar due to limited capacity.
- Free car parking in designated areas where possible.
- Dress code is smart casual. Smart denim is permitted but no ripped or distressed jeans. No trainers or track wear.

<u>Haydock Park - Wednesday 30th December 2020</u>

- Access to the County enclosure. Unfortunately no access to Annual Members bar due to limited capacity.
- Free car parking in designated areas where possible.
- Dress code is smart casual. Smart denim is permitted but no ripped or distressed jeans. No trainers or track wear.
