

Jump Membership 2019/2020 Reciprocal Dates

Sandown Park Jump Members benefit from access to a number of reciprocal race fixtures around the country for 2019-2020. Where possible we have given you the information on what you can access at each course.

Please note that all dates are subject change.

November:

Newmarket (Rowley Mile) – Friday 1st November 2019:

- Sandown Members MUST register at the Free Pass Office on arrival, which is located at the Grandstand and Paddock Entrance (located next to the turnstiles, adjacent to the free car park)
- Access will be granted into the Premier Enclosure, however due to capacity restrictions there is no access to the annual badge holder's facilities or car park.
- Smart/casual dress code: No trainers, t-shirts, sports attire or extreme attire are permitted.
- Car parking is free in the free car park.

Chelmsford City – Thursday 7th November 2019:

- Access to the Grandstand and Paddock areas, this will also include free parking. This area is a smart casual dress code with no sportswear.

Punchestown - Saturday 16th November 2019:

- Access to General and Reserved enclosures and to Members bar.
- Free parking in Members car park.

Punchestown – Sunday 17th November 2019:

- Access to General and Reserved enclosures and to Members bar.
- Free parking in Members car park.

Wolverhampton – Saturday 23rd November 2019:

- Premier admission with access to the 1st floor Premier Suite.
- Free car parking.

December:

Taunton – Thursday 12th December 2019:

- Access to Paddock members stand but unfortunately not the member's car park.

Haydock Park – Saturday 21st December 2019:

- Access to the County Enclosure & free car parking.
- Dress code for the County Enclosure is smart casual, no jeans, trainers, track wear or fancy dress is to be worn.

Haydock Park – Monday 30th December 2019:

- Access to the County Enclosure & free car parking.
- Dress code for the County Enclosure is smart casual, no jeans, trainers, track wear or fancy dress is to be worn.

January:

Wetherby – Saturday 11th January 2020

- Access to the Paddock Enclosure and Premier Enclosure facilities. Due to limited capacity no access to the Annual Badge Holder Suite.
- Parking is in the free public parking areas but no reserved parking.
- Gain access to the Racecourse using your annual badge, via the main entrance at the designated Annual Badge Holder turnstile.
- There is not a formal dress code in any of the enclosures, however they do advise that you dress in smart casual attire.

February:

Market Rasen – Tuesday 4th February 2020:

- Access all three of their enclosures. Due to limited capacity no access to the Limber Hill Bar
- Please use the County Entrance. Entrance through Owners & Trainers will not be permitted.
- Please use the County Car Park.
- All reciprocal members are entitled to book a space in the Altiors restaurant pending availability, please call the racecourse office to do this: 01673 843434.
- A smart casual code is applicable for the County Enclosure. Men must wear collared shirts and trousers or smart jeans (ties not essential) (No ripped or faded denim). No shorts, sportswear or trainers.

Bangor on Dee – Friday 7th February 2020

- No access to members bar or members car park at Bangor on Dee.
- Parking is available free in normal car park areas.

March:

Plumpton – Monday 9th March 2020

- Due to limited space, you do not have access to the Annual Members facilities or car park, however, all car parking is free at Plumpton.
- Racecards can be purchased for £2 each.
- As they race primarily through the winter months, they recommend you check the weather forecast to ensure you are appropriately dressed. However, if you are dining in the Paddock or Marquee restaurant, the dress code is Smart/Casual and smart jeans are permitted.

Huntingdon – Wednesday 11th March 2020

- Dress code is smart casual - no ripped denim or any logo or football/sporting t- shirts.
- Please park in the main car park as there is no access to the Huntingdon Annual Members car park or members bar (Cromwell Suite) due to space restriction.

Fakenham – Friday 13th March 2020

- Access to all enclosures.
- Parking is in the centre of the racecourse. If you wish to park in the Members Car Park a fee of £8.00 per vehicle is applicable.
- The dress code is smart casual.

Newbury – Friday 20th March 2020

- Free car parking.
- Access to Premier Enclosure but not the Annual Member's Bar.
- Encouraged to wear smart attire, gentleman to wear collared shirts (no tie). Smart denim with no rips or tears are acceptable. No sports/denim shorts, t-shirts, vests, sportswear (including trainers), supporter shirts, tracksuits, or bare chests. Gentleman's flip flops/ sandals are not permitted.

Stratford – Saturday 28th March 2020

- Access to Club enclosures & use of car parks.
- Unfortunately no access to Annual Members' Tea Room

April:

Wincanton – Wednesday 1st April 2020

- Use of the Annual Members' car park.
- Due to limited capacity you are unable to access the Premier Viewing Area or the Annual Members Lounge.

Newton Abbot – Saturday 11th April 2020

- Car parking is in the centre of the course and is free – Due to limited capacity you are unable to use the member's car park. Disabled parking is nearside. Parking is free.
- Access will be to the Course and Paddock Enclosures
- There is no strict dress code unless dining in our restaurants.
- Visiting members can use the Annual Members Lounge which is next door to the Owners and Trainers Bar if space permits on the day.

Lingfield Park – Tuesday 14th April 2020

- Access to all public areas but not the annual members bar.
- Free parking in the main public car park.

Cheltenham – Thursday 16th April 2020

- You will have access to the Club and Tattersalls enclosures. There is no access to the member's facilities.
- Parking is free of charge and is located in the Green parking zone. Please follow the Green route when approaching the course.

Fontwell Park – Friday 17th April 2020

- Access to both the Paddock and Premier enclosures. Due to limited capacity, there is no access to the members' room.
- £10 off per head for premier restaurant bookings.
- Members are encouraged to park in the free car park (postcode: BN18 0SX) Limited number of spaces in the centre course- charged at £5.
- In the Premier enclosure there is a smart casual dress code – jeans are acceptable as long as they are not ripped etc. The Paddock enclosure has no dress code.

Epsom Downs – Wednesday 22nd April 2020

- Access to both the Queen's Stand and the Duchess's Stand.
- Free car parking in car parks 3, 6 & 7.

Windsor – Monday 27th April 2020

- Use of the Annual Members' car park but due to limited capacity there is no access to the Annual Members Enclosure and bar.

Punchestown – Tuesday 28th April 2020

- Free parking available in the general car park.
- Access to the general enclosure and the reserved enclosure. Also access to all bars except the Punchestown Members Bar due to limited capacity.
- Dress code is smart casual
